

License Agreement for the Purchase of Electronic Materials

To use the Indiana University Information Technology Training and Education (ITTE) training materials, you must follow all of the points contained in the license agreement below.

In this license agreement, the term "class materials" refers to the original electronic documents created by Indiana University ITTE and any derivative materials created from them.

1. You will not share or distribute the electronic version of these class materials with anyone outside of your immediate department within your educational institution, business, or organization, unless you sign the addendum document which allows you to distribute secured PDF versions of these materials to all members of your institution.
2. You may publicly distribute the exercise files which accompany the training materials.
3. If you purchased Framemaker materials, you will not share or distribute the included Edufont font file with anyone outside of your immediate department within your educational institution, business, or organization.
4. Only staff members of your immediate department are permitted to edit these electronic class materials.
5. You agree that any printed versions of these class materials will be used to teach only members of your immediate educational institution, business, or organization.
6. You agree that any printed versions of these class materials will not be distributed to anyone outside of your immediate educational institution, business, or organization.
7. You will not resell the printed or electronic version of these class materials or any other of the contents of this CD to any person, group or organization.
8. You will not charge for the use of the printed versions of these class materials by members of your educational institution, business, or organization, other than to recover printing costs.
9. Once per semester (three to four times per year), you agree to provide Indiana University ITTE with a count of all printed versions of the class materials that you have distributed during the course of that semester, if requested to do so by Indiana University. We also reserve the right to request a summary of modifications made to any of the class materials and to request you to fill out a short feedback form.
10. If you choose to distribute unedited class materials, then a notice in the format "Copyright 200X - The Trustees of Indiana University" must appear on the Inside Cover page (2nd page) of each set of printed class materials.
11. You are free to modify your own copy of the class materials as needed; however, Indiana University must always be credited as the original creator of the class materials. You agree to never take credit as the original creator of any set of class materials acquired from Indiana University.

12. If you choose to modify these class materials, then a notice in the format "Original class materials Copyright 200X - The Trustees of Indiana University" must appear on the Inside Cover page (2nd page) of each set of printed class materials. You must also add a notice below the copyright statement, in the following format: "Class materials modified by *your organization name* – 200X."
13. You are free to modify or replace the title page of a given set of class materials. Indiana University does not have to be mentioned on the title page, since the copyright notice(s) will appear as described in Items 10-12.
14. This contract is non-exclusive, meaning that Indiana University retains the right to sell these class materials to other organizations, and you are free to acquire additional training class materials from other organizations if you so choose.
15. You agree to send an electronic copy of any modified class materials to Indiana University if requested to do so by Indiana University.
16. If you wish to distribute electronic versions of any class materials or derivative materials on a restricted basis to members of your educational institution, business or organization, you must first gain explicit written permission from Indiana University ITTE. Complete and submit the document "ITTE Addendum for Posting PDF's on a Secure Server" to initiate the approval process.
17. Violation of any part of this agreement by either party shall be considered basis for immediate termination of this agreement and possible criminal prosecution.
