

# Adobe Presenter at IU: Creating Narrated Flash Movies

PowerPoint slides can be enhanced using Adobe Presenter to create navigable movies that may include quizzes

## Download and install Adobe Presenter for Windows at IU

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Adobe Presenter is Windows-only and available at no cost to the IU community at IUware Online for Windows. The files that Presenter creates can be viewed on any computer platform, not just Windows.

  - Download and install [Acrobat Pro Extended 9.0 \(includes Presenter 7\)](#)
  - After installing Presenter 7, you must update it:

    - Click [Acrobat Pro Extended 9.0: Updates for Adobe Presenter 7](#)
    - Download and install all three updates *in order*

## Export (Publish) Adobe Presenter Presentation

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- Export (publish) as a PDF
  - Creates one large file with the contents embedded in it
  - Students will download presentation; student sharing and copyright issues may be a concern
- Export (publish) as a Flash movie
  - Presenter will create several files and directories; make a special folder on your computer to keep all in one place
  - Students will view presentation from within a web browser; sharing is not a concern

## Upload Adobe Presenter files to Oncourse CL

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Upload your Presenter folder or files to Oncourse CL Resources

1. Log into Oncourse CL; access the appropriate site
2. Click Resources in the list of site tools on the left
  - a. If you exported the presentation as a PDF and it is under 200 MB, click **Upload**, then click **Add Files**
  - b. If you exported the presentation as a Flash movie or the PDF is larger than 200MB, click **Upload-Download** and follow the instructions for your operating system
    - Note: WebDAV allows you to move multiple files, folders, or large files (over 200 MB) to Resources
    - Windows Vista users may need to use AnyClient to upload-download in bulk

## Give Students the URL to the presentation

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Once you have uploaded your presentation, give students the URL to the file

- In Oncourse CL Resources, open the folder containing your presentation
  - If you published as a Flash movie, locate the file named "index.htm"
  - If you published as a PDF, locate the PDF file
- To find the URL you'll give to your students, follow these directions: <http://kb.iu.edu/data/auen.html>
- If your students are not members of the site where the Presenter files are stored, the Presenter files must be made public. Information available at: <http://kb.iu.edu/data/atkh.html>
